FY26 Price Control Compliance Statement pursuant to clause 2F.2.1 of NBN Co's Special Access Undertaking

Based on my knowledge as Chief Customer Officer, and on the basis that nothing has come to my attention that causes me to believe anything to the contrary, I certify on behalf of NBN Co Limited (**nbn**) that the Prices included in the Tariff List published on 1 May 2025 under clause 2B.2.3(a) of nbn's Special Access Undertaking (**SAU**) for the Financial Year commencing 1 July 2025 are consistent with:

- the WAPC formula in clause 2D.2.2 of the SAU;
- the Individual Price Controls in clauses 2E.2.1, 2E.2.2(a)-(d), 2E.2.2(h), 2E.2.3, 2E.2.4, 2E.2.5(a)(iii) and 2E.2.6(a)(iii) of the SAU; and
- the TC-4 Price Relativity Restriction in clause 2C.2 of the SAU.

The Backward-looking Price Controls in clause 2E.3 of the SAU have been exceeded in FY25 for the Bundled TC-4 Offers 25/5 Mbps and 12/1 Mbps (non-Basic Bundled Offer) due to actual utilisation in FY25 being higher than forecast utilisation when prices were set for these Bundled TC-4 Offers on 1 May 2024. Consequently, nbn has complied with clause 2E.4 of the SAU as follows:

- in applying the Individual Price Control in clause 2E.2.1(a) for the Bundled TC-4 Offer 25/5 Mbps in respect of FY26, the ACC_{t-1} for that Bundled TC-4 Offer has been set to \$33.83 (the value that would have not exceeded the Backward-looking Price Control in clause 2E.3(a)); and
- in applying the Individual Price Control in clause 2E.2.2(c) for the Bundled TC-4 Offer 12/1 Mbps in respect of FY26, the ACC_{t-1} for that Bundled TC-4 Offer has been set to \$32.45 (the value that would have not exceeded the Backward-looking Price Control in clause 2E.3(b)).

For the purpose of this Price Control Compliance Statement, in applying the WAPC formula and Individual Price Controls:

- the December Quarter CPI used is 2.4%, as published by the Australia Bureau of Statistics on 29 January 2025;
- Prices from 1 July 2024 to 31 March 2025 were ascertained from the nbn FY25 Tariff List, as published on the nbn website:
- the Average Combined Charge for each Bundled TC-4 Offer from 1 July 2024 to 31 March 2025 has been calculated in accordance with clause 2F.4.1 of the SAU and using Daily AVC Peak Utilisation data from the same source that supports nbn's utilisation-based billing reporting;
- the Forecast Average Combined Charge for each Bundled TC-4 Offer from 1 April 2025 to 30 June 2025 has been forecast in accordance with clause 2F.4.2 of the SAU, where the forecast of daily peak utilisation has been derived from a monthly utilisation and volume forecast;
- the quantities $(q_{t-1.25}^m)$ used for each WAPC Charge Component were ascertained from nbn's financial reporting systems, except for some WAPC Charge Components which had a \$0 Price in the Tariff List between 1 April 2024 to 31 March 2025 (pursuant to clause 2F.3(b) of the SAU) or are identified with 'Note 9' in the SAU Price Control Model (where nbn has assumed zero quantities and not increased the price to ensure compliance with the WAPC); and
- nbn confirms that clause 2E.2.6(a)(iii) of the SAU has no relevant application to the Prices in the Tariff List published on 1 May 2025 as at the date of this certification (noting that the circumstances in which that control would apply have not arisen)

Further, pursuant to clause 2D.3.4(c) of the SAU, for each withdrawn Non-Recurring WAPC Charge Component to which clause 2D.3.4(a) applied and the relevant WAPC Reapplication Date was between 1 May 2024 and 30 April 2025, **Appendix A** sets out NBN Co's choice of treatment for p_t under clause 2D.3.4(a)(i) of the SAU. This informed the reapplication of the WAPC formula in that period.

Capitalised terms used but not defined in this document have the meaning given in the SAU.
